

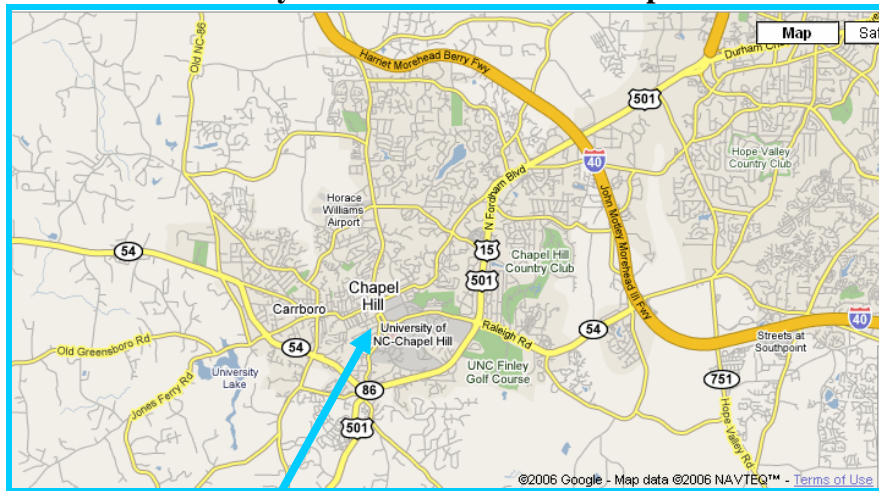

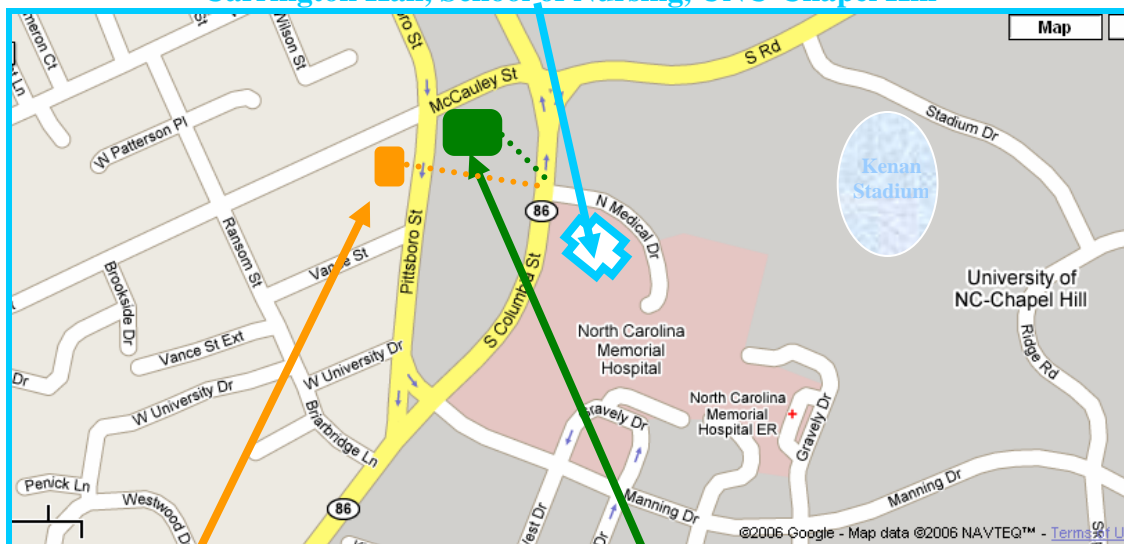
TRAVEL DIRECTIONS (Carrington Hall, University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill)

You must "prepare for success", so don't leave home without a map and a plan to arrive to class on time. Use a NC Highway map to get to Chapel Hill and study the maps below or use Google Maps, Map Quest, or whatever is necessary to find the campus, parking lots and Carrington Hall. **DO NOT WAIT** until the last minute and call somebody to tell you how to get to class! Verbal directions are universally misinterpreted, resulting in a frustrating travel experience and generating high levels of tension. You don't want these feelings prior to GRE PREP or prior to taking the official GRE.

FedEx Global Education Center Parking Garage

PARKING and WALKING DIRECTIONS

Students attending the traditional classroom model can park in the **FedEx Global Education Center Parking Garage** when it is not closed for sporting events. This garage is located under the Global Education Center located at the intersection of Pittsboro and McCauley Streets. See map above. The sign on the garage says "Employees Only" which is true on Mondays thru Fridays; you may park for FREE on Saturdays. After you have parked, walk to McCauley Street and turn right, then walk up to South Columbia Street and turn right. Walk 100 yards and turn left onto N. Medical Drive. Walk 100 yards toward UNC Hospitals and the new Carrington Hall addition will be on your right. Enter the lobby door that has the PrepSuccess GRE PREP sign taped to it. Only one of the external doors to the building will be unlocked, so look for the GRE PREP signs pointing the way.

An alternate parking lot is the **Credit Union Parking Lot** located at 310 Pittsboro Street (see map above). Warning signs are posted regarding parking during business hours, but since Saturday is a non-business day, you will not be towed or ticketed. When parking in the **Credit Union Parking Lot**, you can thread you way between the School of Social Work and the School of Pharmacy to cross South Columbia Street, or just walk up to McCauley Street and then turn right onto South Columbia Street. Carrington Hall will be on the left (east) side of South Columbia Street.

CLASSROOM

The class has been moved to Room L-700 located on the lobby level of the new addition to Carrington Hall.

Plan to arrive for each class by 8:45 am. Campus Security will unlock the Lobby Door at 8:30 am. If you arrive earlier, you may want to visit the coffee shop or cafeteria located in UNC Hospitals. **For security reasons, the lobby door will be unlocked ONLY between 8:30 - 9:30 am and 12:30 - 1:30 pm. Plan to arrive on time for the morning and afternoon session.**

HANDICAPPED PARKING

UNC provides many parking spaces if you have stickers or a license plate authorizing handicapped parking. You will find many slots located on Medical Drive between the Health Affairs Book Store and Carrington Hall.

PARKING ON "GAME" SATURDAYS

When UNC hosts a football or basketball game, parking will be difficult. The Credit Union is taken over by families and the rules for the new FedEx Global Education Center Parking Garage vary; thus, check at the FedEx Global Education Center Parking Garage first, then the Credit Union. If all else fails, you can park in the UNC Hospitals Parking Garage and walk over to the School of Nursing. It is only 1/2 mile away....as the crow flies. Assuming you want the crow's route, enter any of the UNC Hospital entrances and ask for directions to the rear exit located beside the Blood Bank / Old Emergency Room Entrance. The School of Nursing is just outside that entrance.
